Children in Wraparound

In, or at risk of, high-level Group Home Placement and:

- Wards of the Court (W&I 602)
- Dependent of the Court (W&I 300)
- Certified eligible for Mental Health Services (AB3632)
- Mental Health Services Act (MHSA Full Service Partners)

The Wraparound Process Is...

- Built on family strengths
- A team with shared goals
- Based in the family's community with their own support systems
- Designed by the family and team to meet individual needs
- Includes many services, such as a 24-hour crisis support, in-home family specialist, respite options, parent partners, and flexible funding

Approach

- Wraparound:
- Acknowledges the value of each person
- Helps people engage with each other
- Identifies resources to build an effective support plan
- Provides concrete proof of potential
- Creates a spirit of commitment and shared risk taking
- Utilizes what works – including traditional and non-traditional services

Service Coordination

Wraparound is administered by the Shasta County Department of Social Services in collaboration with the following County departments:

- Mental Health
- Office of Education
- Juvenile Probation
- Local Community Providers
- Public Health
- ILP

Referral Process

Wraparound Services are voluntary. Both family and agency needs to agree to participate. The family/caregiver must live in Shasta County.

Referrals are accepted from these Shasta County Agencies:

- Juvenile Probation
- Children and Family Services
- Mental health (via an expanded Individual Education Plan team)

Mental Health Treatment Services

- Multidimensional Treatment Foster Care (MTFC) – Specialized Foster Care and Treatment Services for youth enrolled in Wraparound.
- Mental Health Treatment including:
 - Individual and family, psychiatric services, Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS)
- Access and coordination of MH services by other providers in the community
